



# Nepean's Canada 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Medal

Chandra Arya, Member of Parliament / Député – Nepean

As we celebrate 150 years of Canadian confederation, Chandra Arya, Member of Parliament for Nepean, would like to recognize people who have made a difference in our community or have excelled in their personal/professional life. He would also like to recognize the leaders of today and tomorrow - our youth.

Nepean's Canada 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Medal is in the form of a 36 mm diameter painted gold disc with, on the obverse, the Canada 150 logo with phrases *PROSPERATUS, LIBERALIS, SUPERBUS* (Latin for, "Prosperous, Generous, Proud") and *USQUE LITTORA A LITTORA AD LITTORAL* (Latin for, "From Coast to Coast to Coast") and the date 1867 – 2017 below. The reverse shows the flag of Canada with the name of the MP and riding. The medal is suspended by a 31.8 mm wide ribbon with six red stripes, representing 25-year intervals, thus totalling 150 years.

Please talk to your neighbours and friends. Look around in the organizations you may be involved with. It is an opportunity to recognize the people who serve our community and make it a better place to live. It is also an occasion to recognize people who have accomplished things in their life we are all proud of.

Nepean's Canada 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Medal will be awarded to individuals who have demonstrated exceptional service to the community in the riding of Nepean. The service may have been delivered through:

- Charity
- Not-for-profit organization
- Place of worship
- Social club
- Community association
- School
- Any other organization
- Unsung heroes – a good neighbour and/or those work in the background and avoid the limelight.

The Medal may be awarded to an individual who has achieved a high level of excellence in the areas of:

- Sports
- Science
- Arts and culture
- Profession
- Public service
- Academics or any other field



## Rules for nomination:

The individual must be a resident of Nepean. This is an individual award; an organization or group of individuals will not be considered. We encourage nominations of women, Indigenous peoples, visible minorities and people with disabilities.

Self-nomination is not accepted. Elected officials and their family members are not eligible for the award.

Nomination forms include a write-up on why the nominee deserves recognition. Submissions must include at least two reference letters from those who have direct knowledge of nominee's service and/or accomplishments.

Nominations for exceptional youth (under 18) must be submitted by a school, charity, not-for-profit organization, social club, place of worship or community association. No additional reference letter is required for the youth category.

The nomination period will close on **October 10, 2017**.
